

Weather permitting, the 2025 TEXtreme Grand Prix and State Championships weekend will take place Friday through Sunday, June 6-8. Unlike in the past, the Texas leg of the **2025 Extreme Field Target National Grand Prix series** will be combined with the **2025 TEXtreme Rifle And Pistol Field Target State Championships**. Befitting the greatest competition in TEXtreme Airgun Sports history, the 2025 combination championships boast a prize list value totaling over \$6,000!

TEXtreme's original and primary sponsor, without which TEXtreme would not exist, **Airguns Of Arizona** is generously contributing **\$2,000 in Airguns Of Arizona gift certificates being distributed to podium placers in the Rifle and Pistol competitions, and \$1,750 CASH to be distributed across the top three Rifle podium places.**

Athlon Optics stepped up in a big way to be the 2025 TEXtreme exclusive optics sponsor by donating two great rifle scopes. ***Many thanks Athlon!***

Besides the lucrative cash, gift-certificate and Athlon Optics prize list further detailed below, every competitor completing both rifle matches will also receive Grand Prix points accruable toward the 2025 national Extreme Field Target Grand Prix competition standings and 2025 Extreme FT Grand Prix Champion title. Each rifle shooter completing their first EFT Grand Prix event of 2025 will receive one Grand Prix point; and each rifle shooter completing their second, third or fourth 2025 EFT Grand Prix event will receive 1/2 GP point for completing the Texas leg of the 2025 Grand Prix rifle competition.

Additionally, the 2025 TEXtreme Grand Prix and Rifle State Champion will receive **an additional 3 Grand Prix points, \$1000 CASH, and a \$1,437.49 MSRP Athlon Aeres ETR 15-60X rifle scope!** In case you're not interested in math, besides Grand Prix points, **the Rifle Match Champion pockets \$2,437.49 total cash + Athlon Optics value!**

Second Place in the Rifle competition receives **an additional 2 Grand Prix points, \$500 CASH, and a \$700 Airguns Of Arizona gift certificate! In other words, \$1,200 total cash + gift certificate value!**

Third Place in the Rifle competition receives **an additional one Grand Prix point, \$250 CASH, and a \$350 Airguns Of Arizona gift certificate! So, \$600 in cash + Airguns Of Arizona 'legal tender' rewards.**

Fourth Place in the Rifle competition receives a **\$250 Airguns Of Arizona gift certificate**, and Fifth Place in the rifle competition receives a **\$100 Airguns Of Arizona gift certificate**.

If 24-35 shooters complete both rifle matches, fourth and fifth places each also receive 1/2 Grand Prix point. And if 35+ competitors complete both rifle matches, sixth and seventh places also receive 1/2 Grand Prix point.

In the TEXtreme Pistol Field Target State Championships competition, Airguns Of Arizona gift certificates will be awarded to the top three pistoleros. **The 2025 TEXtreme Pistol Field Target Champion will receive a \$737.49 MSRP Athlon Midas BTR 4.5-27X rifle scope. Second Place in the pistol competition will receive a \$450 AOA gift certificate, and Third Place will receive a \$250 AOA gift certificate.**

Champions in both competitions will also receive TEXtreme Airgun Sports **2025 Rifle Champion or Pistol Champion engraved wall plaques**, and Match Winner hat pins. All Rifle and Pistol competition podium placers will receive TEXtreme Airgun Sports engraved pellet tins reflecting their respective podium placement.

Shooters not entering the Pistol Field Target competition may shoot that match with **any air rifle producing less than 20 foot pounds of muzzle energy** by purchasing a Fun Rifle scorecard, but are not eligible for the Pistol competition awards. If at least three shooters enter the Fun Rifle class, the highest scoring Fun Rifle shooter will be awarded a Match Winner hat pin.

The Full Tournament entry fee includes deli-sandwich lunches on Saturday and Sunday, complimentary snacks and beverages all weekend, a ticket for door prizes, and schwag.

The registration form is attached; as are TEXtreme Rifle and Pistol Field Target rules (sets). Pre-registration by May 15 is encouraged to help with planning. To that end registrations received after May 15 carry a \$20 late registration fee; but registrations will be accepted through match days.

**Sight-in/practice-** See schedule above for practice times. All practice is from a covered porch with four shooting benches, and targets placed at pertinent distances for respective matches.

**Match Courses-** All matches will be shot on 10 shooting lanes around the TEXtreme venue; 6 shots per lane, for a total of 60 shots per match. All target distances will be provided. Extreme Pistol/Fun Rifle target distances are to 55 yards. Extreme Rifle target distances are to 100 yards. Average difficulty factors in all matches will be in the mid-30s to low-40s Troyer.

**Scoring-** Scoring will be 'X' for targets felled, and '0' (zero) for targets that don't fall. Every shot counts on the score-card unless the scorer hears his shooter announce "*Blowing off a shot*". Any trip of the trigger counts as a shot, whether or not a pellet exits.

**Classes and Power Limits-** The TEXtreme FT Rifle matches have only one class, with a strict 100 foot pound energy limit. The Pistol/Fun-Rifle match has a strict 20 foot pound energy limit. All matches allow diablo pellets only. No slugs are allowed.

**Registration and Entries-** The Match Director reserves the right to limit the number of registrations and entries as safety and circumstances dictate. Any closure of entries will be publicized on the Airgun Nation forum and the TEXtreme email list.

Pre-registration is encouraged. A \$150 Full Tournament entry fee includes entry in all three matches, deli-sandwich lunches on Saturday and Sunday, complimentary snacks and beverages all weekend, a ticket for door prizes, and schwag. Rifle Competition Only entry fees of \$125 cover entry in both rifle Grand Prix matches, and all weekend activities other than the pistol match. Single Match and late registration fees are detailed on the registration form. Registration payments by cash, check, money order, or PayPal (Goods And Services) to account name *manicompressive@yahoo.com*. No credit cards accepted. Attendees must sign a liability waiver upon arrival at the event.

**General Rules and Shooter Responsibilities-** SAFETY is the first and foremost concern at TEXtreme matches at all times! Unsafe gun handling may result in disqualification or expulsion. By entering any TEXtreme competition the shooter accepts full responsibility to know, understand, and abide by the rules of safe gun-handling, shooting, and TEXtreme competition rules. All stated rules will be strictly enforced; be they written or spoken. All shooters are advised to- 1) Ask the Match Director for clarification of any rule not understood, 2) Always err on the side of safe gun-handling caution at all times, and 3) Keep your equipment comfortably within rules parameters and power limits.

**Shooting and Equipment Rules-** The Extreme Field Target Rifle and Pistol/Fun Rifle matches will follow the respective rules sets attached, with the following exceptions in order to align with the 2025 National Grand Prix rules (verbatim quotes are *"in italics"*)-

- 1) All rifle competitors in the TEXtreme rifle Grand Prix matches will use timers. *"Time limits for stages and/or lanes must be enforced."* The time limit for each six-shot lane in our TEXtreme rifle Grand Prix competitions will be four minutes. Timers will start before the shooter steps to the the firing line, upon his scorer or timer announcing "timer started". Shots not taken within the time limit will be scored as zeroes on the shooter's scorecard.
- 2) *"No challenging of targets! If it falls, it counts. If it doesn't fall, it doesn't count. Period."*
- 3) Shoot-off will be the preferred tie-breaker. Should shoot-off not be feasible, ties will be settled in this order- most perfect lanes, highest forced-position score, coin flip.

All competitors are encouraged to turn in their score-cards as expeditiously as possible after first checking them for accuracy, then signing them. *"Scorecards will be signed by the shooter and scorer after a review. Incorrect scorecards (higher than actual) will*

*result in a disqualification. Signed scorecards lower than actual will be counted as signed.”*

The generous prize list not only attracts more shooters, and from longer distances, but increases shooters' financial and emotional investments considerably. With that in mind, understand that a single point can make over \$1,200 difference in awards. That being the case, all shooters must respect fellow competitors space and concentration while engaging targets, by keeping conversations subdued and distanced from the firing lines. While inadvertent breaches of competition etiquette may go unpunished, blatant or purposeful violators may be disqualified. The same goes for rules violators.

The substantial 2025 TEXtreme Grand Prix and State Championships prize list demands strict adherence to, and enforcement of all rules. Entry in any competition is considered a contract to abide by all rules of that competition, and it is each competitors own responsibility to know, understand, and abide by all competition rules. The match director often cannot know if a rule violation is inadvertent or purposeful. Hence, often the only fair recourse for all other competitors is to disqualify violators without regard whether a violation was an honest mistake, or not.

In situations not covered in the rules, the match director will have final say; said match director driven by safety, logic, reason, fair play, simplicity, and Majority good.

## **2025 TEXtreme Field Target Rifle Rules**

Match location is Ranchito Robinson, 5636 FM 56, Clifton, Tx. 76634.

Entering a match signifies the shooter agrees to abide by all these rules-

All lead diabolo pellets only; no slugs allowed. Maximum caliber is .30, maximum muzzle energy 100 foot pounds.

Maximum scope magnification is 32X. Absent a 32X factory marking, magnification must be set no higher than the next lower factory marking. Minimum kill-zone size is 1"; maximum KZ size is 4". Kill zones may be of various shapes. Minimum target distance is no less than 20 yards; maximum distance no more than 100 yards. Target distances are provided. Rangefinders and anemometers are allowed.

Mono-pods, bi-pods, and shooting sticks are allowed. The legs must rest on the ground, but may not be driven into the ground. HOG SADDLES such as the BOG Deathgrip longer than 2" are not allowed. Mono-pods, bi-pods, and shooting sticks cannot be attached to the stock, and must fall free when the rifle is picked up. No tripods are allowed.

Bum bags and shooting seats with no arm or back rests are allowed. Shooting seats may not be used to rest the rifle. No other stabilizing accessories or movement-restricting clothing are allowed (such as rifle slings, shooting gloves, and shooting vests or jackets).

Maximum fore-end depth allowed is 6", as measured from the center of the barrel to the bottom of the fore-end.

Adjustable stock components may not be adjusted during a match. No butt-hooks or thigh rests allowed. Adjustable wings on butt-pads cannot exceed 30 degrees. Shooting lanes feature two targets per lane. Shooters shoot targets in near to far order. Except for announced blow-off shots heard by the scorer, all shots count on the score-card. Only the Match Director has authority to make exceptions. Scoring format is 'X' for shots that fell the target, and 'O' (zero) for shots that do not fell the target. Upon completing the course of fire scorers will add all Xs to determine competitors' scores, then total and sign the score-cards. Competitors will then examine their score-cards for accuracy; and when satisfied, also sign their score-cards. Signing your scorecard signifies your agreement that the score on your card is correct, and you surrender further recourse in scoring disputes.

Tie-breakers are (in order) - 1) Shoot-off, if agreed by tied competitors. 2) Most cleaned lanes. 3) High standing lane score. 4) Coin flip. 5) Pissin' match.



## **2025 TEXtreme Airgun Sports Extreme & Magnum Pistol Field Target Rules**

1. Air pistols only. The maximum caliber allowed is .25.
2. Muzzle energy limits are 20 foot-pounds for EPFT; 40 foot pounds for MPFT.
3. Barrel length including shroud and muzzle attachments is limited to 15 inches. Barrel length is measured from the tip of the barrel or muzzle attachment to the breech-face.
4. Maximum fore-end depth is 3" as measured from the bore center-line to the lowest part of the gun forward of the trigger guard, exempting fill nipples, that cannot contact the shooter or bipod while shooting.
5. Attached cylinders at the rear of the pistol are not allowed.
6. Overall length including any attachments cannot exceed 25 inches.
7. No shooting jackets, slings, harnesses, or other bodily supports. Clothing or shooting gloves worn by the shooter must not restrict hand or body movement.
8. Unattached shooting sticks, monopods and bipods are allowed. HOG SADDLES (such as the BOG Deathgrip) longer than 2 inches are not allowed. No tripods allowed.
9. Kneepads may not exceed 1 inch in thickness.
10. Sandbags, knee risers, extended grips, butt stocks, and stabilizers are not allowed.
11. Scope maximum magnification is 16X. Variable scopes capable of greater than 16X are allowed, but must be set to no higher than a 16X factory marking. Absent a 16X factory marking, scopes must be set no higher than the next lower factory marking. Elevation and windage adjustment turret clicking is allowed.
12. Bum-bags and seats are allowed that allow no form of arm or hand support.
13. Time limits may be enforced.
14. Any shooting position is allowed so long as the pistol is fully supported only by the competitor and a monopod, bipod, or natural vegetation. Hangy-tanks are not allowed.
15. Target distances may be between 10 and 55 yards for EPFT; 10-80 yards for MPFT.
16. Kill zones shall measure no less than .5", no larger than 4", and may be any shape.
17. Forced Standing Shots- Other than an unattached monopod, bipod, or natural rest (trees, limbs, etc.), pistols are held solely by the hands, and may not contact the arms or any other part of the body.
18. Light eyecup contact with the face is permitted.
19. Classes- There will be at least one class per match. Other classes may be added as needed to accommodate at least three shooters in a given match.  
Current TEXtreme PFT classes are: A) Pistolero Class: Rules as defined above.  
B) Bandito Class: No shooting sticks, monopods or bipods allowed.
20. Pistol Rear Attachments- Allowed: Rear-mounted Power Adjuster. Reasoning: A power adjuster is an integral part of the gun that does not provide additional support. Not Allowed: Rear-mounted air cylinders, buffer tubes, or grip extensions. Reasoning: May provide additional support, stabilizing ballast, or raised positioning of the gun.
