Hi Airgun Fans

DeSoto Airgunners held our Mothers Day Field Target Match with a turn-out of 11 enthusiastic competitors. The week leading up to today's club match could be described as tropical with near equatorial temps and humidity. Fortunately we had a welcome reprieve on Sunday as a 'cold front' and a thin overcast sky kept conditions unexpectedly comfortable, under 90 degrees for most of the match. Occasional gusts felt refreshing and added to the challenge on a few long distance shots.

Chip and Dennis set the course with help from early arriving volunteers. Before Event Marshal and Club Scribe Ron z arrived Scott had all the targets painted and sorted for the days event. Dennis and Chip were configuring the course. Carl arrived early on his classic motorcycle and brought a clever fixture he made for mounting our tree target.

Today's 48 shot event was spread over 8 lanes (3 targets per) with lane 5 designated a kneeling lane. Lane 7 was the off-hand standing lane and was shot from atop the club's airplane boarding ramp.

Several Field Target Divisions were represented in today's event. Gary and Ron G. practiced their WFTF skills – they are planning to compete in the 2024 World FT Event later this year. Lindsay shot Hunter with a TX spring-piston rifle while Bill shot a modified 'unlimited' Hunter style.

Dennis earned today's **TOP GUN** recognition with a score of 46, dropping only 2 shots.
